- You are looking for a remote place to dive.
- The rain and the wind are not an impediment to going out to sea.
- You are tired of going to places with large groups and inexperienced people.
 - You don't mind spending hours on the high seas to find sharks and mantas.
 - You would like to interact with dolphins and watch whales in the wild.

Introduction

The WILD AZORES program is specifically designed for those who carry the adventurous gene ingrained in their hearts. Those who seek the places furthest away from man, where miracles still exist.

Only 9 divers will be able to join us on this 7-day adventure in the wildest Atlantic. Underwater volcanic landscapes, open water and remote dive sites are part of this adventure. The reward... diving with blue sharks, mobula rays in the middle of the blue, large schools of pelagic fish, expeditions in search of dolphins and observation of sperm whales with more than 15 meters length in our Giant Kingdom Expedition.

Our Trip offers scuba diving, freediving and snorkeling, as well as whale watching and informational Sea Talks.



Blue Shark Expedition






One of the highlights of this expedition is to encounter one of the most fascinating pelagic predators: the blue shark (Prionace glauca). During the summer months the waters of the Azores are concentrated with individuals from 2 to 3 meters length.

His curious attitude towards divers gives us the chance for very intimate interaction. You will learn interesting facts about this shark and its behaviour in our Sea Talk.

This expedition takes place in the high seas, without reef references and at a depth below our feet of 600-1000m. Due to these characteristics and the possibility of having current, we require that you are certified as a PADI Advanced Open Water / Deep Diver or equivalent and recommend that you have a minimum of 50 logged dives.





PRINCESS ALICE BANKS is the most famous diving spot in the entire Archipelago. It is located 80km from the coasts of Pico and Faial.

Communication to the mainland is only possible via satelite phone at this destination. This is a full day expedition in which we will spend **2h 30min** sailing until we reach our dive spot.


We will be carrying out 2 dives at an underwater volcano that emerges from the depths. The top of the volcano reaches a depths of 35-40m. We will do a deep dive to explore the reef and a midwater dive to observe pelagic species. Large schools of barracudas, bonitos, horse mackerel await us. And of course, during the summer months the mobulas (Mobula tarapacana) are added at this point in various numbers. An authentic spectacle in the middle of the blue.





In between the islands of **Pico** and **Faial**, we will be searching for interactive dolphins. If we suceed, this will be an unforgettable experience of a lifetime!

This expedition will last approximately 3-4 hours and we will take turns in pairs to jump into the water. Only two people at a time may be with the animals to minimize the impact on their behavior. Among the most common species are the bottlenose dolphin (Tursiops truncatus), common dolphin (Delphinus delphis), striped dolphin (Stellena Frontalis), Risso's pilot whale (Grampus griseus) and pilot whale (Globicephala macrorhynchus).








Leaving the Azores without seeing the locals would be crazy. The Giant Kingdom is the last expedition of this trip.


The location of the Azores Islands, their nutrient-rich currents and rugged underwater landscape make it possible to watch more than 20 species of cetaceans (whales and dolphins) throughout the year.

Specifically, the waters of **Pico** and **Faial** have become a world benchmark in the transition from hunting to sustainable tourism. Since the 1980s, the hunting of sperm whales (Physeter macrocephalus) has been prohibited and now this species abounds on these coasts.

The great depths of these waters make it possible to observe these giants, which feed on squid at a depth of 1,000 meters.






Our "base camp"

Recommendations & Requirements

We require that you are certified as a PADI Advanced Open Water/ Deep Diver or equivalent and recommend that you have a minimum of 50 logged dives. Unpredictable and strong currents are to be expected in certain areas. All dives are carried out in drift dive mode, so we will always use our surface marker buoy (SMB is mandatory to rent if you don't have your own).

Although the water temperature will be above 22C°, in some cases we will be in the sea for many hours and it can be cold. Therefore we recommend a 5mm wet and/or semi-dry suit.

Professional and action cameras should be able to record in wide angle to capture big sharks and mobulas.

Don't forget clothes for wind and rain. The summer months (June - October) are the months with the least rainfall but the conditions of the Atlantic are unpredictable. We also go out to sea when it rains.

Bring some cash (€), since in some establishments it is difficult to pay by card.

Arriving and Departing Horta Airport (HOR)

The best way to arrive to Faial Island is by plane. Azores Airlines operate daily direct flights (duration around 2h30) between Lisbon and Horta Airport in Faial.
